New Students

Existing Students

School of CS encourage students to return to campus for Teaching and Learning (TnL) activities to take place effectively in Semester 1 Academic Year 2020/2021. Below is a schedule to guide students returning to campus based on their cohort's year:

1. Year 2 - Week 2 : 19 Oct 2020 (f2f session would start in week 3)
2. Year 3 - Week 3 : 26 Oct 2020 (f2f session would start in week 4)
3. Year 4 - Week 4 : 2 Nov 2020 (f2f session would start in week 5)

All TnL activities will start on Monday, 12th Oct 2020.

Teaching and Learning (TnL)

For Semester 1, Academic Year 2020/2021, all TnL would be conducted in a mode known as Blended Learning Substitution (BLS). It is a combination of Face-to-Face (F2F) and Online mode of delivery. Each course would detail out in the course planner the slots for F2F and Online. Course Planner would be provided to all students registered for the course prior to the start of the semester.

Blended Learning Substitution

While all students are expected to be in campus (for conducive learning environments), students would have to physically come to CS/Lecture Halls/Tutorial Rooms/Labs ONLY for the F2F slots as per planned in the respective courses' course planner. For other times, students would be following Online TnL sessions at any convenience places within the campus. All F2F sessions would follow COVID19 SOPs.
